



\$25.00 Late fee for entries not RECEIVED by the closing date  
 \$15.00 Office Fee required  
 \$15.00 Federation Fee with each entry (Drugs & Meds \$7/USEF fee \$8)  
 \$30.00 USEF non-members for EACH rider, owner, trainer (& coach if applicable)  
 \$20.00 USDF non-member fee for both owner/lessor and rider  
 \$ 5.00 USDF non-member card affidavit (or send a copy of your USDF NM Card!)

- **USDF Horse ID** or Horse Lifetime Registration number is required. Include copies of your USDF Horse Registration or HID card. If you do not have a USDF HID or Registration, you will be required to buy either a USDF Lifetime Horse ID (\$20 fee) or Lifetime Horse Registration (\$85 fee). If you have a USDF HID or Lifetime Registration number but cannot provide proof, you will be required to fill out a USDF affidavit and pay an additional \$5.00 fee before you are allowed to compete.
- **Entries will not be accepted without** a copy of 2008/2009 Negative Coggins Test and a copy of a Rabies certificate (signed by a veterinarian, valid within one year of competition date). For rider, owner, trainer, (& coach if applicable), and horse include copies of your USEF membership cards, proof of USDF membership or nonmember ID, USDF Horse ID/Registration, and if GAIG/USDF Qualifying, USEF Lifetime Horse Recording, a completed and signed entry form, and all fees. Incomplete entries or those requiring membership lookups will be charged a \$5.00 penalty fee.
- Refunds will be given for cancellations received in writing before the closing date less a \$15.00 office fee. If for any reason a class(es) or an entire day(s) needs to be canceled due to an act of God, national tragedy, or any other reason, no refunds will be made. **No refund after Closing Date for any reason.** Changes to entries after the Closing Date will be charged an additional \$5.00. Non-compete horses require a signed entry blank, current Coggins and rabies forms.
- **Measurement** of ponies will be by appointment only. Please contact manager before the show. Owner to pay all fees for vet & pony measurement certified TD.
- **Make checks payable to: Cayuga Dressage & Combined Training, Inc. and mail with entry form to the Secretary.**
- **POST ENTRIES** will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis if space is available. Classes entered after the closing date will cost an additional \$5.00 per class. Class changes after the closing date will cost \$5.00 per change.
- **TIMES & ACNOWLEDGEMENTS** Tentative times may be obtained via the Internet: <http://www.cayugadressage.org>. Times will be available 3 days before the show. If you do not have access to the Internet, contact the Show Secretary to obtain your times (leave a message and your call will be returned).
- **MANAGEMENT NOTES:** Management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes, if entries warrant. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current Federation rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
- **STABLING** - Permanent wooden stalls with full doors are available on the grounds after noon on Friday for \$40.00 per day or \$70.00 for the weekend. Bedding is not provided but will be available to buy. Tack stalls are \$40.00/day or \$70/weekend. Show horses have stabling preference over non-compete horses. Bridle numbers are to be worn at all times when a horse is out of the stall.
- **SERVICES:** Medical personnel will be on the grounds during the show; a farrier will be on the grounds during the show and veterinarian (posted at show office) will be on call. Phone numbers will be posted in the barn area and at the secretary's stand.
- **REFRESHMENTS:** Available on grounds. Complimentary Wine and Cheese Party Saturday at 5pm.
- **DIRECTIONS:** From East-Route 17 West to Horseheads; turn left on Grand Central Ave. Fairgrounds are on the left. From West-Route 17 East to Horseheads; turn right on Grand Central Ave. Fairgrounds are on the left. **ACCOMMODATIONS:** Holiday Inn 607-739-3681 / Howard Johnson 607-739-5636 / Motel 6 607-739-2525. Camping is available at \$25/night, payable under "other fees" on the entry form.

## **MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT**

**Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. Federation Rule GR301.5 states: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license.

**ATTENTION COMPETITORS:** Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct association numbers (USDF, United States Equestrian Federation) for horse, owner, rider and trainer, before the day(s) of the competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.
