July Meeting Minutes: Motion to approve by Norm, seconded by Kathy. Motion approved.

Treasurer's Report: Anna reported a healthy profit from our recognized shows.

Dressage in Wine Country: License agreements have been signed with USEF/USDF for August 24-25, 2024. We need to find a management service ASAP. Shannon will talk with Anita and Stan to see if they might do it. Judges were discussed. The group recommended we ask Kem Barbosa back (Shannon will ask her) and Lisa El-Ramey (Sarah H. will check with her). We will need a TD if Anita takes on managing - she may have a suggestion. We will see if Sydney Jennison wants to be the EMT and Grace Putnam wants to be the show farrier for both days. Will offer the farrier a stipend, much like the show vet. Need to confirm a vet practice soon with the USEF rule stipulation regarding pony measurements in mind. Norm will ask My Eva food truck if they would be willing to commit to the entire weekend. Otherwise, we will ask PDR Catering. TIP awards applied for for all 2024 shows. Sponsor thank you notes are done and website updates are forthcoming. The Chemung County Fairgrounds are aware of our 2024 dates and contracts will be signed in January. The National Dressage Pony Cup classes brought in 6-7 riders and Carol volunteered to sponsor the partnership again next year. Shannon will ask Camille Holmes about being the show photographer for all of our 2024 show dates. Suggestion made to bring a few buckets and rags to the show to clean the arena as we set it up, rather than cleaning it and sticking it back into the trailer prior to the show. Shannon proposed maybe offering a specific DIWC special award or two just for CDCT members to encourage joining the club

Keeping It Casual Show: June 9, 2024 has been set as a tentative date. Sarah H. has talked with Paula Wedemeyer about having the show at Ithaca Equestrian Center.
