It is officially Dressage in Wine Country month! What a wild and crazy ride it's been, changing dates, locations, judges, and all the other logistics involved with hosting recognized shows. This newsletter is going to be very show-heavy, but I am the secretary after all and this becomes a huge part of my year!

First off, let's talk about entries. Each unique horse and rider pair becomes an entry. You will use the same number for Saturday and Sunday but each day is a different show. That means you may be riding in a different arena each day. We try our hardest to schedule so that you ride under a different judge each day - two rides, two judges, two competitions means double the opportunity to get those qualifying scores! Entries can either be snailmailed to me or submitted online via eqentries.com. I am keeping track (of everything, haha) of competitors that submit everything correctly up front; those who don't make me track them down to get additional information may very well be entered to win a special prize! So make sure your entries are entirely complete before submitting - owner, rider, trainer signatures (NO "SAME"), you have all you and your horse's USE-F/USDF membership numbers squared away, your horse's shots and coggins are within date, and of course you triple checked your math and made sure to pay the right amounts. Participating competitions must submit a copy of their prize list to USDF no later than 14 days prior to the competition and competition results must be submitted to USDF within 21 days of the end date of the competition.
