

February Minutes: motion by Colleen to approve and Norm seconded. Motion approved.

Treasurer's Report: Deferred to next meeting **Old Business:**

Committees 2023: Still time to sign up!

Recognized Show: Waiting on contract from Stephanie Warner/Dressage Extensions. Per Stephanie they are still adjusting fees and they will send us a contract. Norm has solved the food issue for the show. We have a caterer hired for Saturday that will take orders in the morning and then deliver meals. They will also cater the wine and cheese party Saturday evening. Sunday we hired an on-site food truck. Vouchers will be given to volunteers/show staff for meals. Coffee/tea/water to be provided by the club. Jane-Marie will talk to Lucas, Sarah will talk to Damiani, and others suggested approaching a few other area wineries for wine. Norm Foley will do Saturday as the show farrier, Jason Turk may still be able to do Sunday. Norm will be the volunteer coordinator but will need a volunteer manager for both days at the show. Colleen will do Saturday, Kathy will do Sunday. Shannon will send Sonya Lawlis a vet contract. Motion to order custom CDCT directors chairs to go under our fancy new tents, all in favor.

Casual Show: Contract signed with Regina Cristo for judging. Norm to reserve a port-a-potty. Prize list almost done. Finger Lakes PC wants to serve food as a fundraiser - approved by the group. Dinah will be the volunteer coordinator. A few volunteers have signed up but many more are needed!

Western Dressage Clinic: July 21st-23rd, 2023 at Healing Rein. Deb Moynihan as the clinician. A \$2000 grant application was submitted to The Dressage Foundation, keep your fingers crossed! If approved, we cannot make a profit but the numbers seem extremely fair for a three day clinic. There will be rides in groups of two, split into western dressage competitors and western dressage curious. This opens the clinic up to the newest beginners and to seasoned pros with no pressure. Day three will be ride-a-test or private lessons based on each participants wants. More info to come!

Open Centered Riding Clinic: Colleen is looking at hosting this at Healing Rein. This would be with Kathy Culler out of North Carolina for a weekend with emphasis on dressage and jumping. Please let Colleen know of your interest.

2024 "L" Program: Colleen is willing to plan an "L" Program next year for CDCT to host. Norm made a motion that we pursue putting on an "L" Program, Jane-Marie seconded. Motion carried. While it is a big undertaking, there is support from other GMOs and a few barns in the area that would meet requirements. There were only two "L" Programs scheduled in 2023, one in NY and one in Michigan and CNYDCTA had a waiting list. A committee will be created to help with planning.

Swag Updates: Prin handed out samples of bumper stickers. Will order for show for club members and others for show participants. Tents have been ordered.
