Treasurer's Report - not a whole lot of change. Norm motioned to approve, Tina seconded.

Old Business:

Recognized Show - still waiting on a contract for Stephanie Warner. Per Stephanie, they are still adjusting fees and they will send us a contract when this is done. Western Dressage Clinic - Deb Moynihan coming to Healing Rein July 21-23, 2023. The Dressage Foundation awarded us a \$1000 grant making the participation fee \$325 each for the three days. Auditors are welcome with a discount for club members. Stabling at Healing Rein and Asbury available for \$30/day. It will run 8-5:30 and will take up to 12 riders. Deb Moynihan is willing to stay Monday if people would like lessons.

L Program - Colleen is looking into organizing a USDF "L" Program in 2024. RULES

Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or change the order of classes as deemed necessary.

The show will begin at 8:30 AM and will end after the last test is ridden.

All dressage tests will be ridden in a large size (20m x 60m) indoor dressage arena. Warm-up will be in an outdoor ring, rain or shine. The stadium jumping classes for the combined tests will be in the indoor arena at the conclusion of the dressage tests.

The show is an informal schooling show. The dress code is neat and tidy, braids are optional. ASTM/SEI Certified helmets are required when mounted.

Class fees are listed in the table below and are dependent on CDCT membership status. Join today and save on entry fees! www.cayugadressage.org/membership

Entries must be RECEIVED by the closing date. If the show is cancelled due to COVID-related reasons, all entry fees will be refunded. "Acts of God" will not be refunded. There will be NO refunds for individual changes or cancellations after the closing date, no exceptions.

All fees must be paid in full and all necessary paperwork must be submitted PRIOR to arriving to the show grounds. Upon arrival, please check in to receive your number and sign a facility waiver. Scoring will be tabulated as quickly as possible and ribbons and tests will be set out for pick up. Results will be posted on our Facebook and website following the end of the show.

A limited number of stalls are available for \$35/stall. No tack stalls are available. All stalls must be stripped at the end of the day. Shavings not provided. Please indicate if you want overnight stabling on your entry form.

Tests may be ridden out of sequential order. Riders will have at least two tests break between rides. There will be no more than five horses in the warm-up ring at any time. In the event of a test change after the closing date, your ride times will remain the same regardless of tests chosen. Ride times will be posted on the CDCT website at least three days prior to the show date - www.cayugadressage.org. There is a class change fee of \$15 after the closing date.

If riding in a Test of Choice (TOC) class, please be sure to indicate which test you want to ride on your entry form.

Total number of tests ridden cannot exceed three. No dogs allowed.

All competitors are required to provide a Negative Coggins, proof of Rabies Vaccine, and proof of EHV/EIV Vaccination within one year of the show date with your entry form.

Thoroughbred Incentive Program

General Information & Links

To encourage the retraining of Thoroughbreds into other disciplines upon completion of careers in racing or breeding, The Jockey Club created the Thoroughbred Incentive Program (T.I.P.). T.I.P. has a number of programs geared toward all riders and Thoroughbreds. Generally, all information on T.I.P. programs can be found on our website (tjctip.com) under "TB Owners & Riders".

Eligibility - For purposes of eligibility for all T.I.P. classes and awards, a "Thoroughbred" is defined as any horse that has been registered with The Jockey Club or a foreign Thoroughbred stud book recognized by The Jockey Club. Unregistered horses are not eligible.

T.I.P. Numbers - To participate in T.I.P., owners and riders must obtain a T.I.P. Number. To apply for a T.I.P. number, please visit tjctip.com and click on "My Account". You will need an Interactive Registration™ account to apply for a T.I.P. Number. Interactive Registration™ is a FREE service designed for the use of thoroughbred owners and breeders to transact business electronically with The Jockey Club registry. T.I.P. Numbers are free. The T.I.P. number card should be provided to participating horse shows as proof of eligibility.

- T.I.P. Numbers are horse/owner specific. If you purchase a horse with a number, you need to get a new T.I.P. Number for the horse under your own account.
- All riders must be listed on the T.I.P. Number – to add a rider, log into your account and click "Add Rider"

Horse Show Awards – T.I.P. offers sponsorship of Thoroughbred classes and high point awards at approved horse shows in virtually all disciplines, including hunter/jumper, eventing, dressage, Western, polo, polocrosse, and endurance.

Performance Awards – The Performance Awards are T.I.P.'s year end, self-reported Thoroughbred "points program". The Performance Awards are completely self-reported by the Thoroughbred's owner or rider. The Award Year is December 1 - November 30 and all forms are due December 20.

Recreational Riding Program – The Thoroughbred Recreational Riding Incentive Program (TRRIP) is designed to recognize and reward Thoroughbred owners and riders that enjoy recreational riding or driving on a regular basis. There are prizes associated with each hour level, beginning with 25 hours.

Championships – The Jockey Club hosts an all Thoroughbred Championship Horse Show with championship divisions for Hunters, Jumpers, English Pleasure, Dressage and Western Pleasure. T.I.P. offers championship awards for eventing at the United States Eventing Association's American Eventing Championships.

Young Rider and Non-Competition Programs – T.I.P. offers a Young Rider of the Year Award and a Youth Ambassador Program as well as a Thoroughbred of the Year Award which recognizes a Thoroughbred that has excelled in a non-competitive career, such as equine-assisted therapy or police work.

The clinic is expected to begin at 8AM and conclude at 5:30PM each day.

The clinic will take place in an indoor arena complete with a viewing/lecture room.

July 21st and 22nd, riders will be paired for lessons depending on whether they are “western dressage curious” or seasoned western dressage riders. July 23rd will be the rider’s choice of a 35 minute private lesson OR performing a fix-a-test consisting of riding a test, getting feedback, and then riding the same test a second time.

The rider participant fee for all three days is \$325 and includes instruction while riding, class clinics, Q and A sessions, food, and a goodie bag. Auditors are welcome at a per day rate of \$50 for CDCT members and \$60 for nonmembers. The number of participants is capped at 12 with preference given to CDCT members – join today!
