
Began at 6:47 PM.

- Susan Harris Centered Riding Clinic:
 - •Hosted by Healing Rein Farm in October 2022.
 - •Working on submitting a TDF grant for \$1000 which would roughly make costs \$175 members/ \$225 nonmembers for the weekend.
 - •Available to 10 participants + auditors welcome. Stalls available to bring your own horse.
 - •Clinic focus on groundwork, riding, and more.
 - •Possibly of having an Alexander Technique teacher present for private sessions.
