#### Minutes from January Meeting: Motion by Colleen to approve and Norm seconded.

**Treasurer's Report:** Anna noted the \$220 paid for wine sent to the winner of our GMO basket at the USDF Convention. Jane-Marie sent a case of Lucas wine to a Region 9 GMO winner. Memberships rolling in and USDF fees rolling out. Still in good financial standing overall.

#### **Old Business:**

- Committees 2023 Please sign up for committees!
- Recognized Show Judges, TD, and photographer have signed contracts. Waiting on contract for Stephanie Warner as apparently it is too early to sign per Stephanie/Dressage Extensions. Still need to figure out what a vet contract entails for Sonya Lawlis to sign. Jason Turk is too busy to be the show farrier. Kathy will talk with Jean to check with Norm Foley. We will have a Small Horse Division with ribbons for 1st through 6th place, sponsored in part by Tracy Durham. CNYDCTA is donating \$250 and sponsoring a Special Award probably Empire Award/NY bred horse.
- Food updates Much discussion ensued regarding the ongoing issue of availability of food during DIWC. Shannon read the USDF requirement regarding food at a level 2 show. It is quite nebulous, so could be met with ordering from somewhere and brought in. A vendor need not be present on the grounds. A suggestion was made that riders check a box if they desire a bag lunch. A suggestion was made to have coffee and donuts available for riders and volunteers.
- Casual Show Norm will send a contract to Regina Cristo for judging. Camille will again be photographer. We need to reserve a port-a-potty. USDF Regional Schooling show application and fee are paid. Shannon is working on the prize list. Next year's show date needs to be coordinated with CNYDCTA and Carriage House shows. Can we get some sponsors for this show?

#### Western Dressage Clinic

Colleen Price would host at Healing Rein. Callie Klein is having some health issues, so she suggested Deb Moynihan as the clinician. Colleen will follow up on this. Looking at a \$2000 TDF grant. More info to follow.

#### Swag Update
